Country Reels Under the 2nd Wave of the Pandemic Kerala Turns into a Hotspot, Ernakulam District worst hit in the State, Aluva Municipal Town Hall Converted to a COVID Domiciliary Care Centre FBROF AGM Scheduled for 6th June stands Postponed

In the wake of the grave situation prevailing all over the country on the unexpected 2nd wave of the COVID - 19 , the alarming ever increasing Covid positive cases and casualties in Kerala, the 'never seen before' spreading of the pandemic in Ernakulam District wherein Aluva, the location for our proposed AGM situated and the venue of the AGM, the Municipal Town Hall already converted into a COVID Domiciliary Care Centre, the Executive committee meeting held on line on 5th May 2021 decided unanimously to postpone for the time being the AGM proposed to be held on 6th June 2021.

The Committee expressed serious concern on the very grim situation arising out of the current unabated surge of the 2nd wave which is considered to be more lethal than the 1st wave we experienced last year and appealed all our members to take every precaution possible to keep away the pandemic from our doorsteps. The Committee also decided to continue the groundworks already started for the successful conduct of the AGM hoping that some kind of normalcy would return at least before the end of the 3rd quarter of this year so that we may be able to conduct the AGM this year itself.
