Formation of Confederation of Bank Pensioners and Retirees Organizations (CBPRO)

We are happy to inform members that the National Leaders of the undernoted five organizations of the Pensioners and Retirees in the Banking sector at the National level met at New Delhi on 28th July, 2015 and formed Confederation of Bank Pensioners and Retirees Organizations (CBPRO):

- 1 Federation of State Bank of India Pensioners' Associations.
- 2 All India Bank Retirees' Federation.
- 3 All India Bank Pensioners' and Retirees' Confederation.
- 4 Retired Bank Officers' National Confederation.
- 5 All India Retired Bank Employees' Association.

The Confederation was formed with the main objective of strengthening the movement of Bank Pensioners and Retirees by bringing together all the major organizations at the National level and work together for resolving industry level issues concerning pension, medical facilities and other welfare measures of pensioners and retirees of the member banks of Indian Bank Association.

It was decided at the meeting to form a Joint Action Committee with a Convener and two members each from the Federations.

Steps have been initiated to represent our core pension issues with the Govt. /IBA/ Management of banks. It was also decided that the leaders of the Federations will meet during August, 2015 when action programmes will be finalized and declared. Due to unavoidable reasons the meeting has been postponed and will now take place on 22nd Sept, 2015 at New Delhi.
